Broomfield Academy Enrollment Referral Program

Broomfield Academy families receive a \$500 academic tuition credit for each family they refer (and who attend the school for the majority of the academic school year). The tuition credit earned is spread out over ten months.

Middle School Founding Family Program

The first 25 current or past Broomfield Academy families to become Middle School Founding Families receive a 50% reduction in 7th and 8th grade tuition for each of their children. A \$1,000 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit, which will be applied to 8th grade tuition of the youngest child, allows a family to become a Founding Family. This program is to reward current and past families for their long-term support & commitment. Once a new family enrolls at Broomfield Academy, they are eligible to join this program.
